NOTICE OF MANTOUX TUBERCULIN TEST

To: All (full and part time) Substitute Teachers, Substitute Secretaries, Substitute Paraprofessional, Student Teachers, school bus drivers/aides and volunteers who have contact with students.

If you are substituting in the Long Branch School District and have contact with students, and are new to the New Jersey School system, you are required to submit **Documentation** of a **Montoux Tuberculin test** to the **School Nurse** of the school you are substituting, Mrs. Devaney – Central Office- can always send to me as well. You may receive the test at your primary care physician – it must read within 48 hrs – if you do not want to return to your primary care physician – any of the school RN's can "read" the results.

Exceptions:

Tuberculin skin testing is not required for volunteers working with pupils for less than **20 hours** per month.

Tuberculin skin testing is not required for new employees, student teachers, and contractors of the district with a documented negative Montoux Tuberculin test results in the last six months. If the result was positive – a copy of the blood work or chest x-ray must be submitted.
