F. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Salvatore – January is National School Board appreciation month. The individuals up here are special to not only our school board but to our community as well. Mrs. Perez is passionate about serving other people; Mrs. Peters strives to ensure equity and opportunity to the children in our schools; Ms. McCaskill is a social justice advocate who wants to make sure everyone has a voice in our schools; Rev. Bennett is guided spiritually and keeps us in her thoughts and prayers all of the time; Mr. Zambrano makes sure that our operations and finances are on point; Dr. Critelli makes sure that we are providing high quality programs for our students; Mr. Grant is the longest sitting Board member, every week he has something to say, every month he has something to say and it certainly is always a surprise and we welcome him; our new Vice President Mrs. Youngblood Brown is a graduate of Long Branch High School and is driven to make sure that we are always expanding opportunities for our children in our schools and making sure our district is getting better and last but certainly not least, Mr. Covin, our Board of Education President who is a life-long resident of this community and a graduate of Long Branch High School. You may know him from his coaching days but he also is a passionate educator and past principal of the Middle School. I thank all of you for your partnership and support and I look forward to the great things to come in the future.

1. COMMITTEE REPORT - INSTRUCTION & PROGRAM

Mr. Covin - The Long Branch Public Schools has an unprecedented number of students enrolled that require bilingual and ESL services. In fact, over the past 5 years we have had a 215% increase in students requiring ESL services. In an effort to accommodate this rapidly changing demographic, we have developed innovative programs aimed at improving English as a second language. A few examples of our unique programming include evening ESL classes for more than 100 parents weekly. Furthermore, we have a Family Literacy series that teaches families concepts of print fostering academic dialog in the home. Currently we are servicing more than 1,200 students in 9 schools.

2. COMMITTEE REPORT - OPERATION & MANAGEMENT

Mr. Zambrano - Last evening the Board discussed the technology improvements for the district to include the following:

- We have upgraded the telephone system throughout the entire district in order to ensure continuity and security.
- The district expanded a network upgrade which included increasing the transfer of data from one gb per second to 10 gbs per second. This will eliminate any back log of data during high internet use.
- The district is installing a new battery back-up solution which includes full redundancy to help keep the network system up and running in the event of intermittent power failures.

Facilities

- The district has embarked upon an energy savings program which will include approximately \$10 million with upgrades to lighting, heating and air conditioning and other critical systems in the district. The payment for these improvements will be achieved through savings in utility costs. The Board is looking to close on the bond sale sometime near the end of February.

Good evening Dr. Salvatore, Members of the Board of Education, Central Office Administration, faculty, parents, and members of the community who are in attendance this evening. This is my monthly report:

The Gregory school led by Mrs. McCarthy has established a clear path towards creating a school that focuses on both social and emotional learning. In fact, this is one of the school's new initiatives. The Gregory School wants to create an environment where they meet students where they're at to best assist with their needs. With things such as the monitor skills lab and programs with the YMCA, the school ensures that its primary focus is on the energy of the students. The school and its staff recognizes that students will potentially face obstacles and therefore it has designed a system of alternate seating in addition to recess and breaks in between classes that are already provided in order to ensure that students have an outlet to express positive energy. Gregory school is also proud to highlight the strong academic programs available to its students. The administration and staff work diligently to offer the best academic experiences for students that help foster their learning. Further, there is a collective effort to provide all the necessary materials to make the school's curriculum accessible to all of its students.

Mrs. McCarthy was most excited to highlight the continuation of the "Leader In Me" program that was created in the school. The "Leader In Me" program encourages students to recommend a peer to be selected as the leader of the month. Along with the recommendation, students also submit an explanation as to why they recommend that certain student. One deserving student is selected to represent each grade level each month and he/she is rewarded with an invitations to attend a special recognition assembly each month. Not only this, but Mrs. McCarthy is also excited about the fact that this month marks her 5 year anniversary at the school. She explains that although she's been at different places, the students and staffs

determination makes her love the school. She appreciates seeing how each teacher helps the students grow each year and she is extremely proud that as a school, when they set their minds, there's nothing they can't accomplish.

The Audrey W. Clark School is led by Ms. Kristine Villano. This year the AWC School is continuing to work on their sustainability initiative that really took off last year! In addition to their hydroponic gardens, the AWC School has hatched, raised and maintained several chickens. These chickens reside at the school and different classes volunteer to take turns in the duties necessary for their proper care. Additionally, these chickens lay eggs daily and the program has been able to utilize the eggs in a multitude of ways. Last month, Ms. Villano highlighted on the school's twitter page a science experiment done with their organic chicken eggs versus store bought eggs. The students were able to see significant differences in the eggs produced in their building in comparison to what is generally purchased in the supermarket. The students will also be able to sell the eggs and use the profits to continue their sustainability project.

Ms. Villano is also excited about the schools newest instructional focus on reading and writing fluency from the elementary grades up. The teachers are able to use data provided by link-it assessments to see exactly where their students are missing important skills and then focus on those skills to ensure that when they reach their high school years they are fully prepared.

Audrey W. Clark School is designed to meet the individual learning needs of students to help them develop socially, academically, emotionally, and behaviorally. The overall goal at Audrey W. Clark School is to provide students the opportunity to learn in a smaller setting and an environment comprised of strong support and innovative teaching. This alternative learning approach is not meant as something negative, but in fact it is something positive as it provides more one on one individualized instruction in the areas where students need support.

Audrey W. Clark School takes great pride in their initiative of providing a learning atmosphere that is different from the rest of the schools in the district through the incorporation of unique classroom settings that make student learning more enjoyable.
